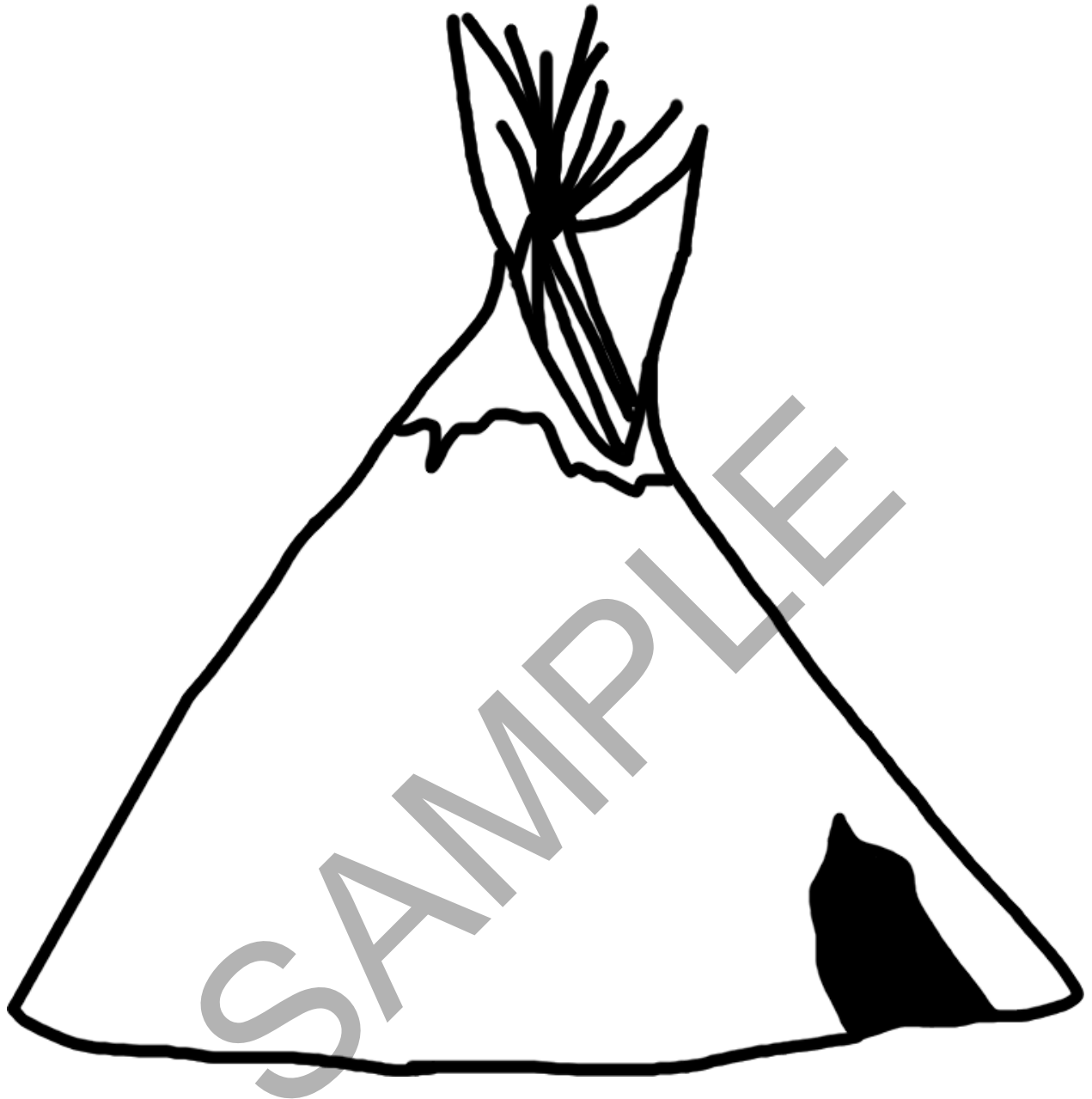
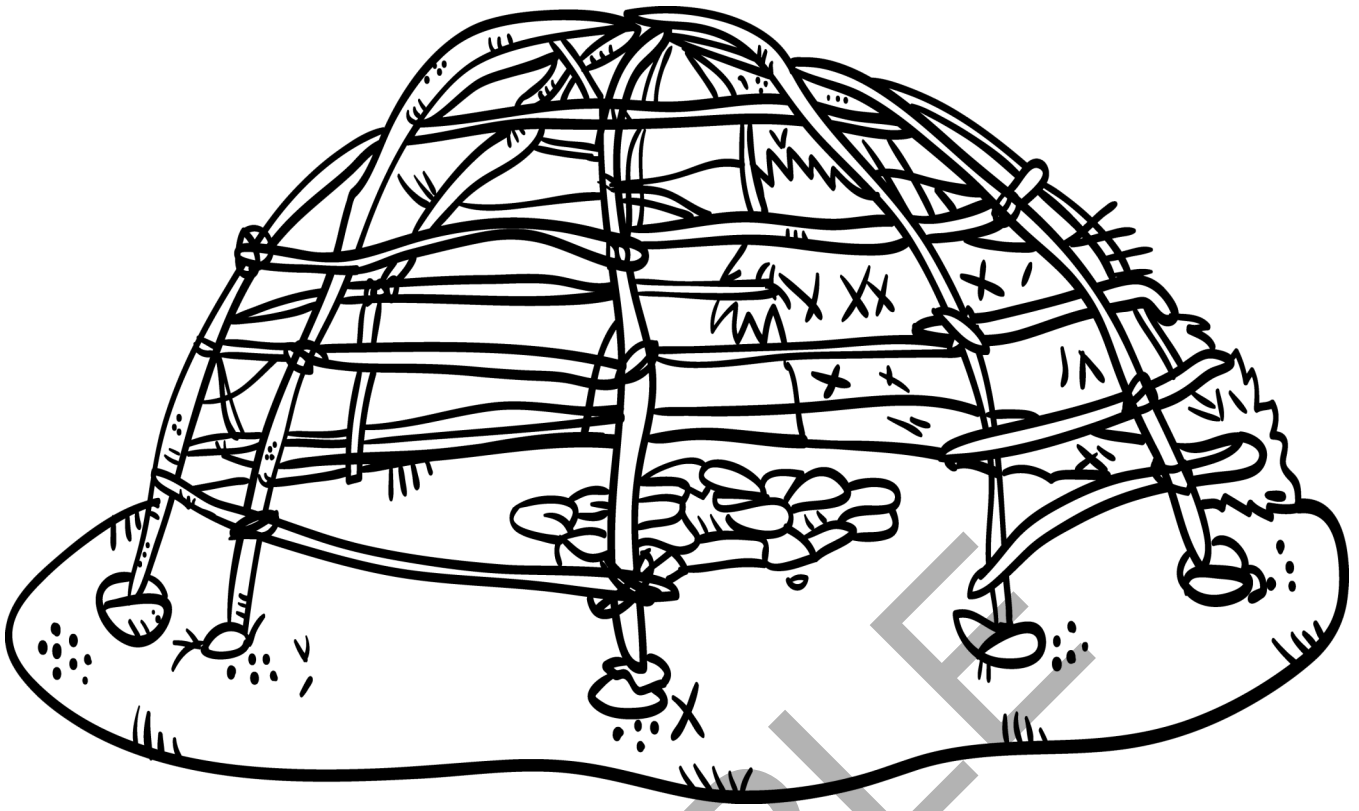




The Apache lived in

part of Mexico.



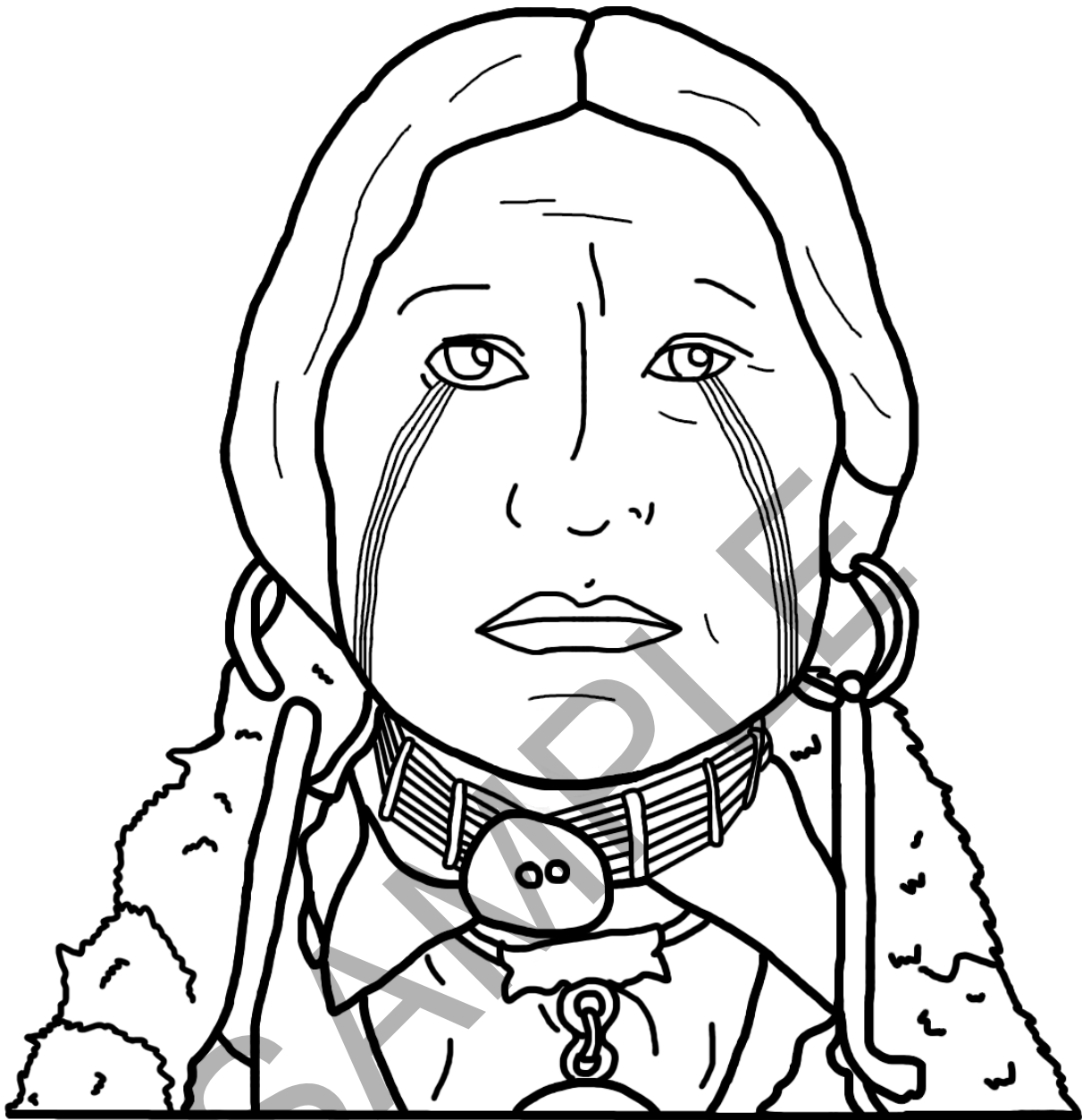
Many Apache lived

at the top.



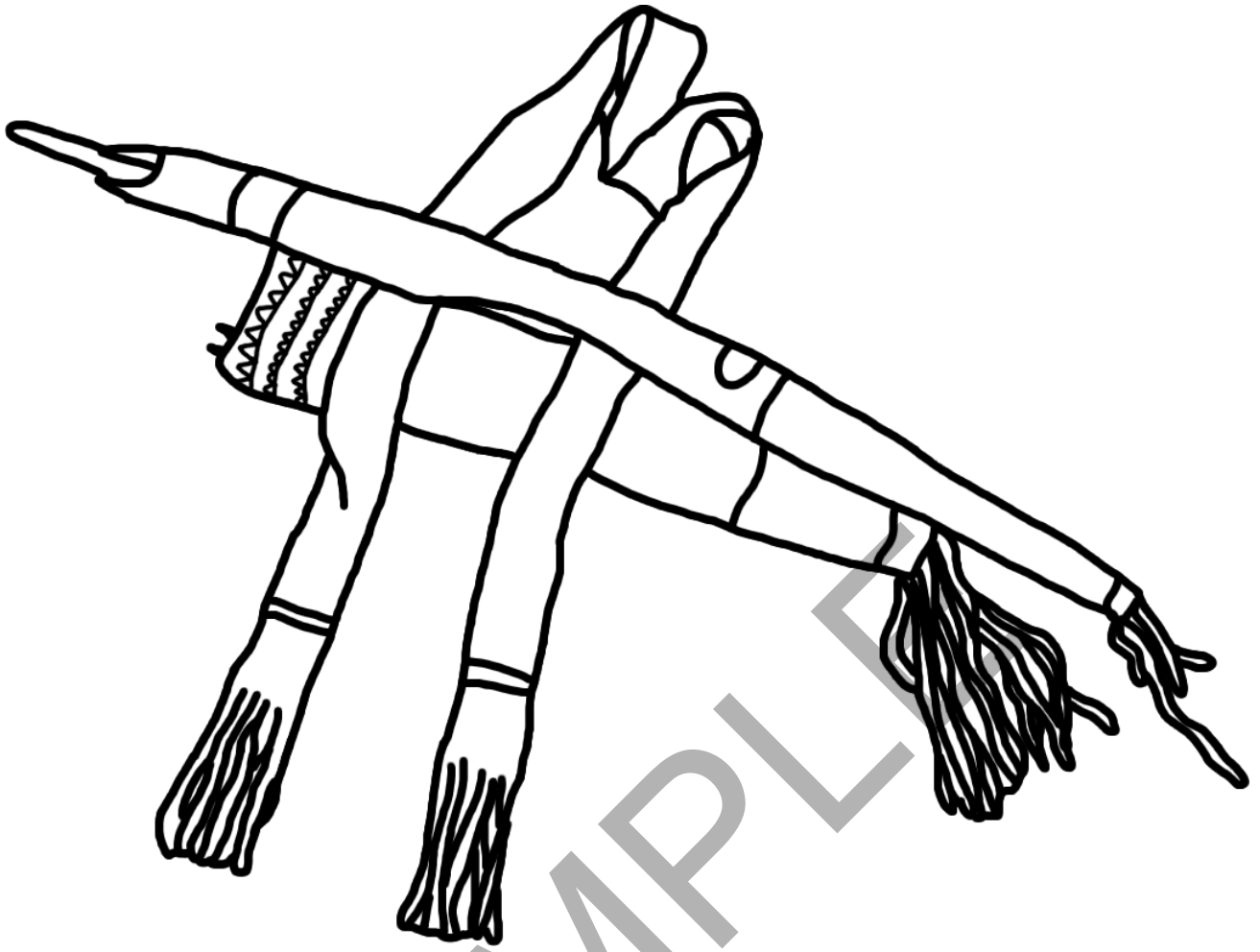
They were covered

grass or bark.



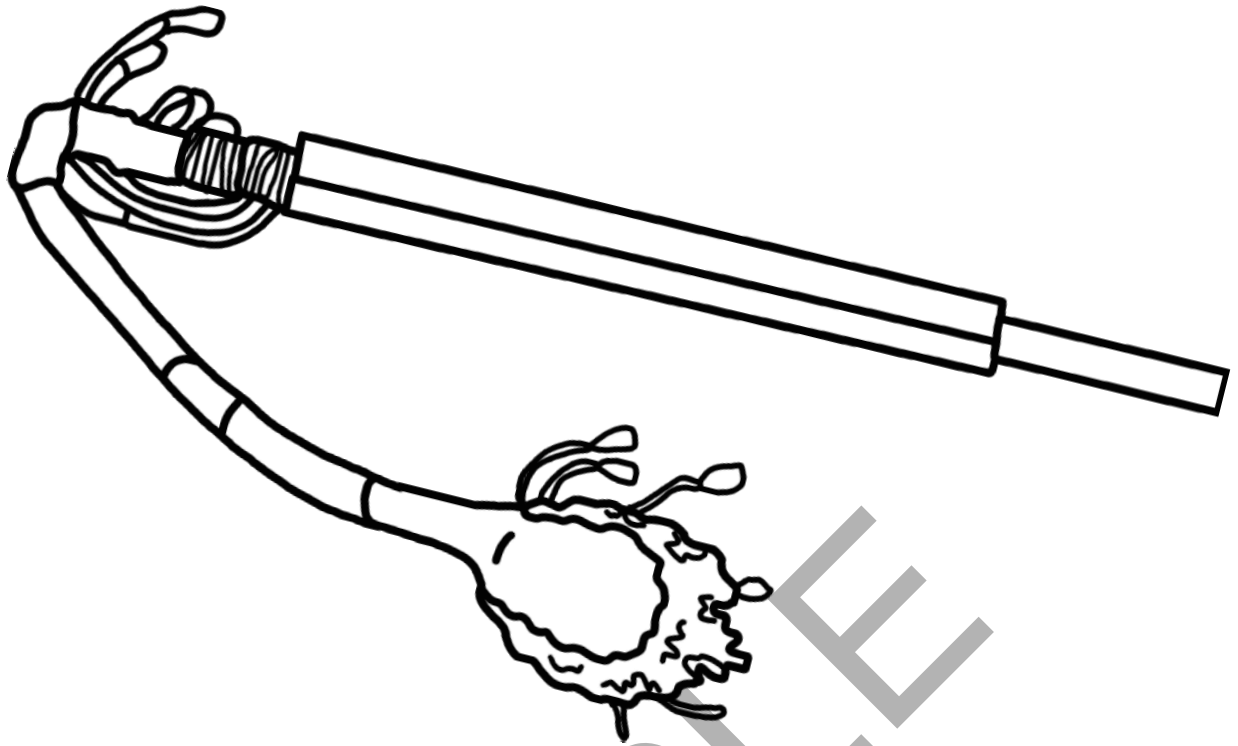
Apache men
