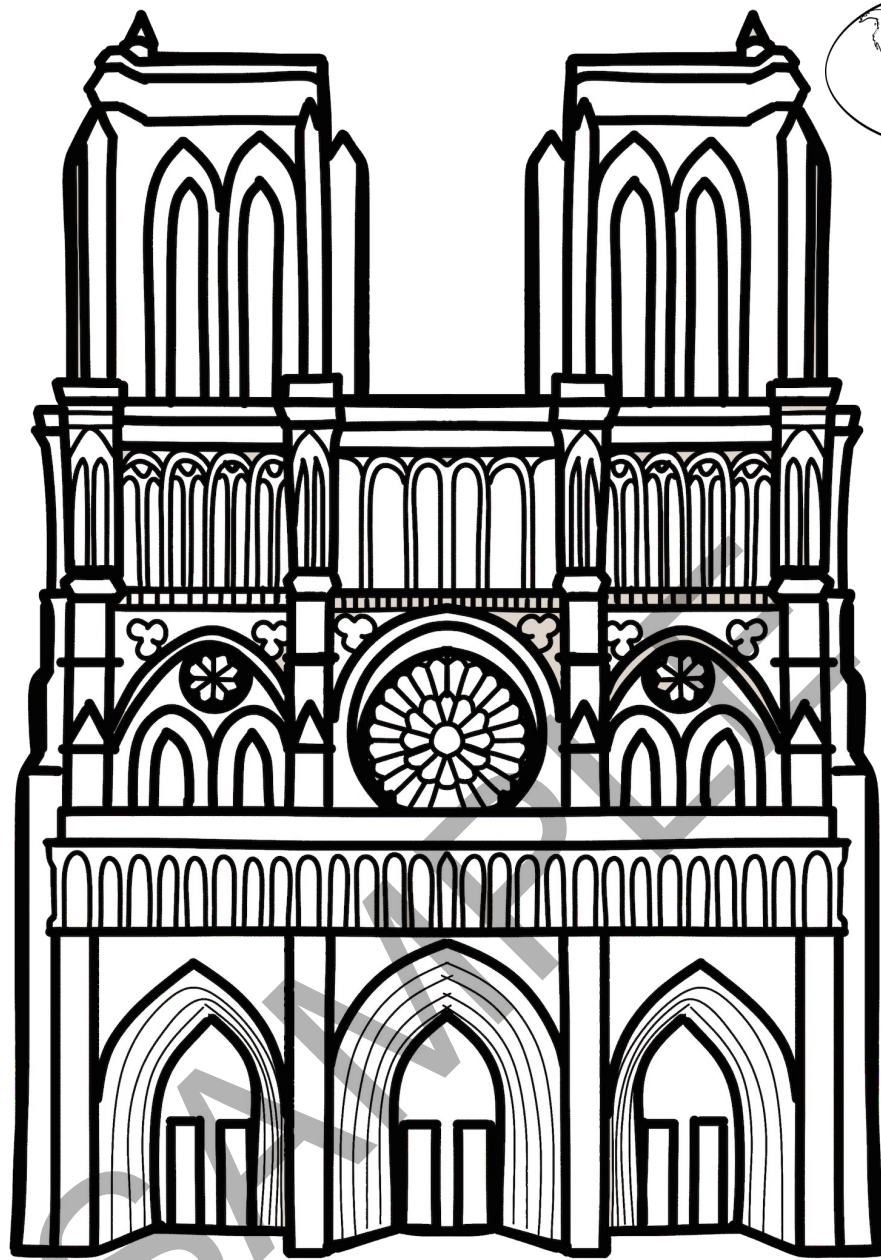
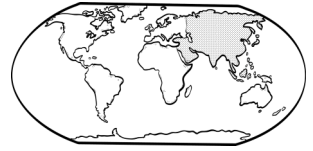


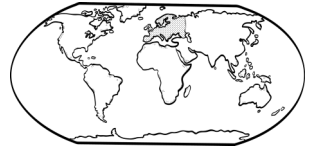
Henry II was king of

for legal reforms.



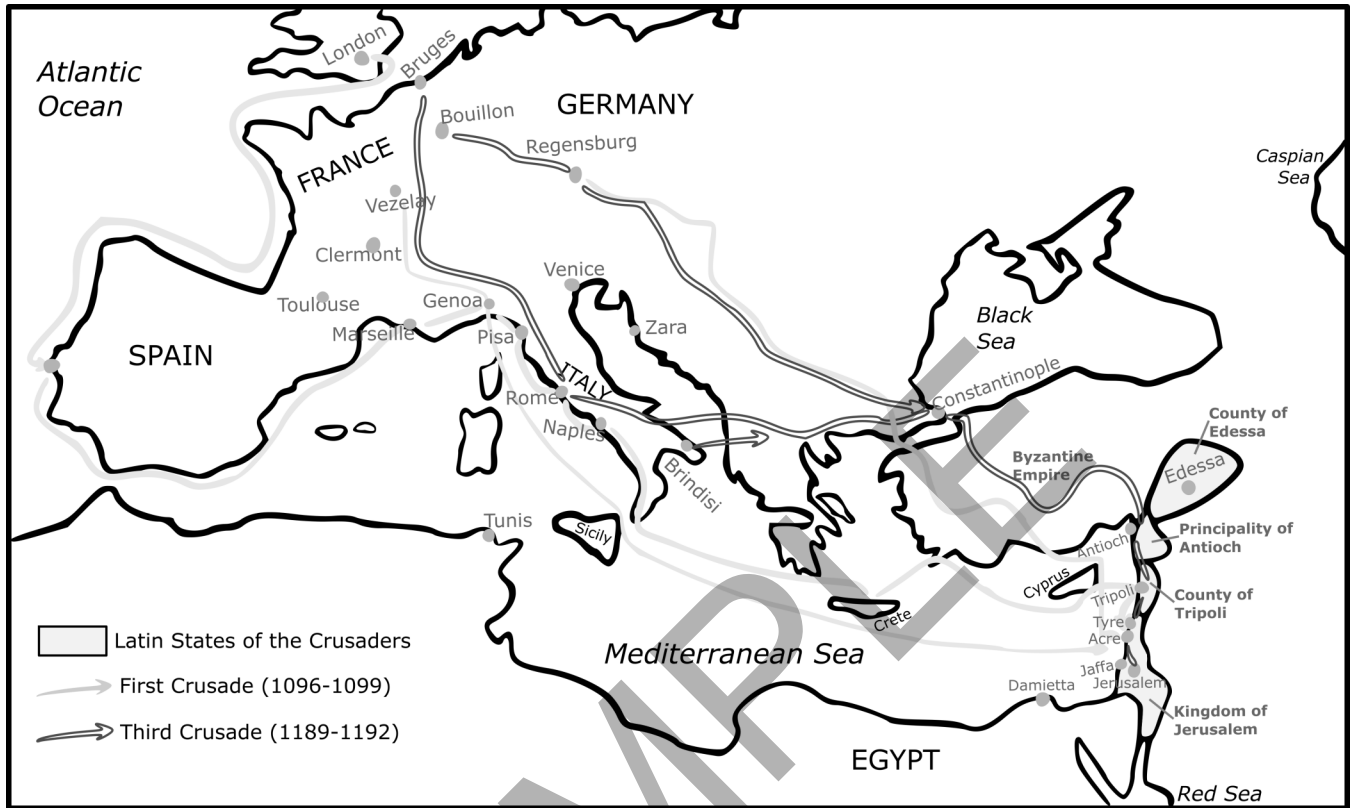
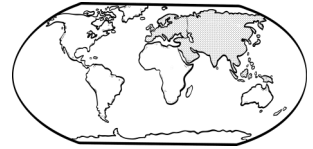
Construction began
