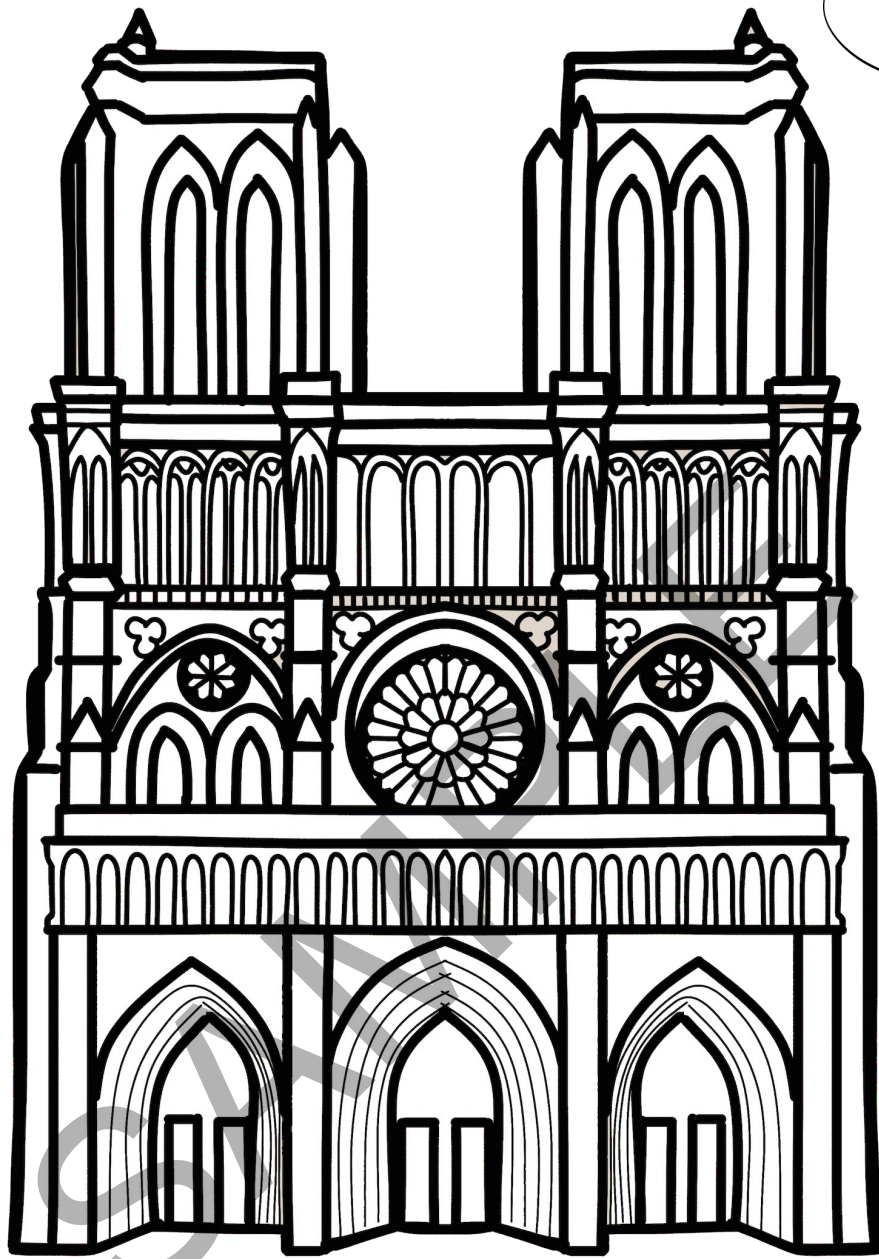
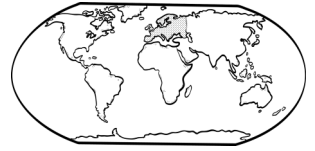
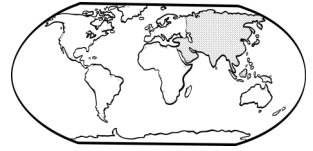




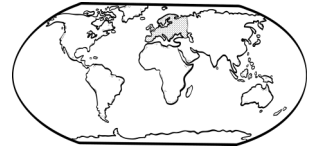
Henry VII was king of

for legal reforms.



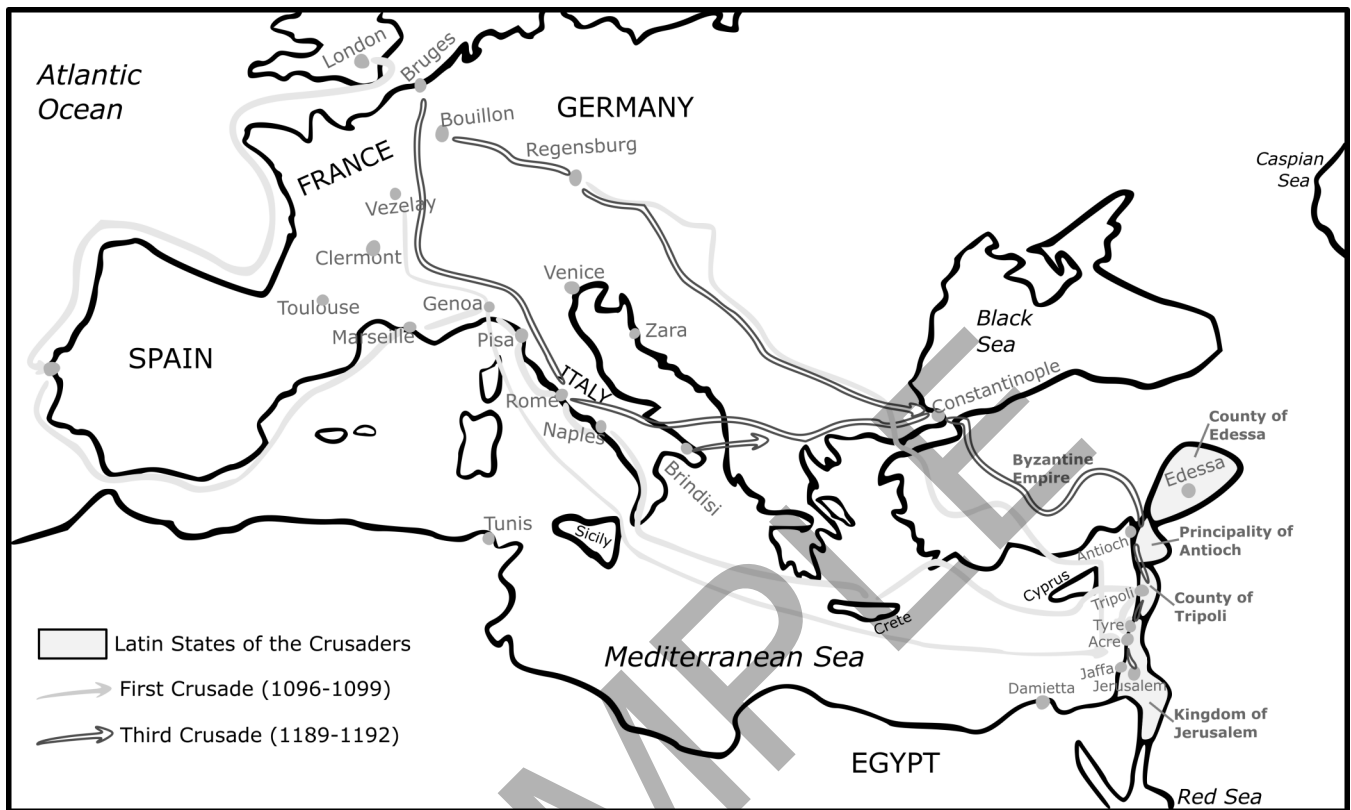
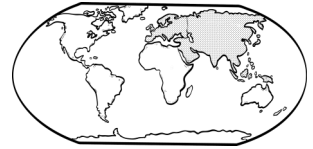
Construction began on the
